Description	A monthly cash settled future based on the difference between the Argus daily assessment price for WTI Houston and the Platts daily assessment price for Dated Brent.

Trading Price Quotation	One cent (\$0.01) per barrel

Last Trading Day	Last Trading Day of the contract month
Floating Price	In respect of daily settlement, the Floating Price will be determined by ICE using price data from a number of sources including spot, forward and derivative markets for both physical and financial products.

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Final Settlement	<p>In respect of final settlement, the Floating Price will be a price in USD and cents per barrel based on the difference between the average of the quotations appearing in the "Argus Crude" report under the heading "US Gulf Coast and Midcontinent", subheading "Weighted average" for "WTI Houston" and the average of the "Mid" quotations appearing in the "Platts Crude Oil Marketwire" under the heading "Key benchmarks (\$/barrel)" for "Brent (Dated)" for each business day (as specified below) in the determination period.</p> <p>Non-Common Pricing Applies.</p>
